Curriculum Leader Job Description

ROLE SUMMARY

The Curriculum Leader contributes to the improvement of instruction in the school through the structures they create for teachers to learn together and from one another. The Curriculum Leader also serves as a liaison between teachers and the school leadership so that school-level decisions are informed by ongoing, two-way communication between teachers and other school leaders.

The Curriculum Leader is responsible for guiding the team's work and ensuring it is coordinated with school goals. To this end, s/he leads effective data-based inquiry, guides colleagues to make instructional decisions informed by the professional knowledge base, supports effective instructional practice, and cultivates a professional culture of shared ownership for student learning in the school.

QUALIFICATIONS

Education, Training and Experience

- At least 2 years of educator experience
- Must have a DESE certification

LENGTH OF SERVICE

Curriculum Leader appointments are for a period of one year.

COMPENSATION

The annual stipend for Curriculum Leaders shall be per teacher contract, Schedule C.
